

Kicking Cancer's Ass ~ Hoxsey the 'Quack'

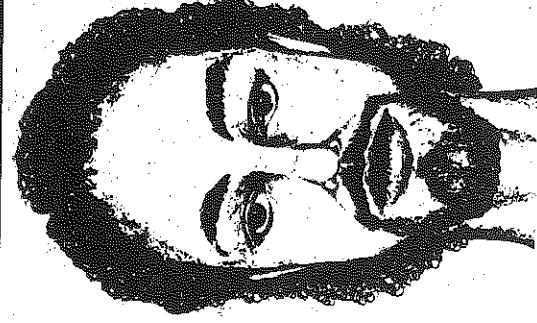
It is our choice that we have remained dumb and allowed our spines to bend and our hearts to empty to such an extent that fear disallows us from rising up and speaking out and acting against injustices performed by the mighty upon the vulnerable, the trusting, and the innocent. Our children, grandchildren and heirs not yet born deserve more from us than to be left with a world where individual thought, truth and and love become subordinate and subservient and blindly, senselessly obedient to fakes and tricksters who wear compassion and flaunt fancy credentials to mask selfish motivations rooted in their own ignorance and fear.

In 1924 Harry Hoxsey opened his first cancer curing clinic in Illinois. He had taken a family formula of healing, first learned by Hoxsey's great-grandfather from observing the "natural" recovery of an ailing horse, and set about curing the incurable.

By the 1950s Hoxsey had clinics in 17 states, with his major headquarters in Dallas. Time and time again journalists were sent out to investigate and expose the "quackery." Time and time again the investigators learned that the real quacks were the ones who were out to get Hoxsey for stepping on their medical turf.

For 25 years a ferocious battle raged between the medical establishment, led by Morris Fishbein, kingpin of the *Journal of*

the AMA, and Hoxsey. Eventually Fishbein was humiliated in courtroom proceedings which showcased testimonials from Hoxsey patients who were cured in his clinics and by his methods.

Yet the National Cancer Institute and organized medicine continuously refused to answer Hoxsey's offer and challenge to officially test out and investigate his claims and his formula and his success. The mighty powers declared that answering Hoxsey's challenge would lend credibility to a "quack." Never mind that the "quack" was curing cancer.

Congress held hearings in the 1950s and

in the "Fitzgerald Report" concluded that the medical establishment was conspiring to stifle alternative healing treatments. But as Congress has been wont to do following important hearings and discoveries, the "problem" was left to fester. The representatives of the people evidently feel their job is effective as long as they can make an announcement. Sort of like saying "I love you" to one's wife and then hitching a ride to the local brothel.

In short time following the congressional hearings, at least a dozen treatments besides Hoxsey's were banned without an investigation. So much for promoting the general welfare of "We the People" under the Constitution of the United States.

Faced against unending pressure from all angles of accepted authority, in a move forced ultimately by the FDA, Hoxsey closed his operations in the United States and relocated to Mexico in 1963. One of Hoxsey's nurses, Mildren Nelson, who had begun working for Hoxsey after he cured her mother of cancer, took over the Mexico operations. Following Hoxsey's recommendation, made for obvious reasons, Nelson dropped the Hoxsey name.

About a year and a half ago Mildren Nelson died. But the "Hoxsey" clinic, still so-called unofficially by visitors and patients, still heals afflicted people to this day under the name, Bio-Medical Center in

called pau d'arco and its abilities and history of fighting cancer.

Part Seven talked about media and medical monopolies and the dangerous interplay between the two. It also mentioned the names of herbalist Dr. John R. Christopher, scientist Royal Raymond Rife, and "unqualified" healer Harry Hoxsey, whose suppressed healing success stories should and shall be told.

Part Eight talked again of Christopher and offered feedback from readers on pau d'arco and suppressed healing methods.

In Part Nine, Bob Houchins of Port Charlotte, Florida narrated the story of Royal Raymond Rife, "one of the most fascinating and horrifying tales ever told." Rife was an American scientist who discovered a method and created an instrument that cured cancer in the 1930s. How many of you have heard of Harry Hoxsey?

Could the suppression of such a story steer us to the real cancer problem? Could the cancer problem be a problem within our medical, media and political establishments more so than anything else? Is the cancer problem more about health and healing or about power and money? And what happens to those who ask too many related questions? Do we need more research money for new cures or more brains, hearts and guts in digging up and spreading existent cures that people deserve to know about?

Hoxsey Therapy:

General Background ~ Perhaps no therapy has had as colorful a history as that of the late Harry Hoxsey. An herbal folk healer with a fanatical following, Hoxsey's herbal therapies date to the 1840s and his great-grandfather who bred horses in Illinois. One of his horses had cancer on its leg and was put to pasture to die. Instead, the horse began grazing on certain plants in the pasture, and was cured. Hoxsey's great-grandfather later mixed the plants into a salve and used it to treat horses. Hoxsey's father, who was a veterinarian, also used the salve. Harry Hoxsey, who assisted his father, also learned how to make the salve.

Although vigorously attacked by the ACS, Hoxsey herbal remedies were also used by Native Americans to treat cancer and the formula contains herbs with established anticancer properties.

The Hoxsey method was placed on the ACS Unproven Methods List in 1968. The Hoxsey Clinic, located in Tijuana, Mexico, estimates that 80 percent of the patients who use the Hoxsey formula benefit substantially.

Case History:

In 1979, a fifty-six-year-old woman was sent home to die after her surgeons found a tumor the size of a ping pong ball in her right ovary. Exploratory surgery had shattered the tumor into several pieces, causing it to spread throughout her body. Her colon and liver were particularly affected.

The woman visited the Hoxsey Clinic to begin treatment. Taking the tonic daily, she began to feel better within a few weeks. She continued the treatment for six years, at which point she was able to discontinue taking the treatments, due to full restoration of her health. Today, fourteen years after receiving a death sentence from her doctor, she remains vigorously healthy.

Below is the text of a letter written by a U.S. senator to Harry Hoxsey in 1947.

United States Senate
Committee On Appropriations

June 2nd, 1947

Dear Mr. Hoxsey,

I have your favor of May 29th and note the further difficulties you are having in carrying on your work.

It seems that the medical fraternity is highly organized and that they have decided to crush you and your institution, if at all possible. I have had a few "rounds" with the heads of the medical organization as well as the Public Health Services here in Washington and it seems that the public officials are afraid that if they make any move, or say anything antagonistic to the wishes of the medical organization that they will be pounced upon and destroyed. In other words, the public officials seem to be afraid of their jobs and even of their

lives. This presents a most serious case and I am at a loss to know how to proceed. I am of the opinion that what the medical organization does will be repeated by the several state organizations in the event any Congressman or Senator started out to publicly oppose their program. I have done what I could to have your remedy or at least the record of your accomplishments considered and passed upon but, to date, the authorities here have refused to act.

If I find wherein I can do anything further to help you out I shall gladly avail myself of the opportunity. If you receive a reply to your letter to the Pure Food and Drug Administration, I shall be glad to have a copy of the same.

Hoxsey eventually won a slander suit against Dr. Morris Fishbein, head of the *Journal of the AMA*, which forced Fishbein to resign in disgrace. There was little doubt that Hoxsey was curing cancer, because there were too many recovered patients willing to testify on his behalf. But Hoxsey claimed that AMA officials went after him because he would not sell them his formula. In the end, however, the FDA was brought into the act and closed Hoxsey down. One of his former nurses took the treatment to Mexico where American cancer patients have sought help ever since. The human aspect of this program, therefore, is the story of one surviving Hoxsey clinic which is now flourishing in Tijuana. Contains remarkable historical footage. One hour and 36 minutes.

The Hoxsey Family Formulas

Originally developed in the nineteenth century by John Hoxsey, the Hoxsey Therapy for cancer has been passed down from generation to generation. This therapy is comprised of herbs and other substances believed to have antitumor effects. Some of these substances are combined to form a tonic that is taken internally, while others are used to make a salve designed to heal external lesions. The following shows the specific ingredients used in each of the Hoxsey therapies:

Internal Tonic:

potassium iodide
red clover
buckthorn bark

burdock root
stillingia root
berberis root
pokeberries and root
licorice root
Cascara amarga
prickly ash bark

External Paste:

zinc chloride
antimony trisulfide
bloodroot

For those who cannot travel to get these formulas, there are companies in the United States that sell similar combinations designed to have the same effect.
